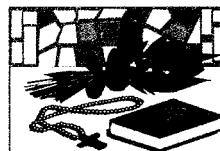

Scripture Reflection

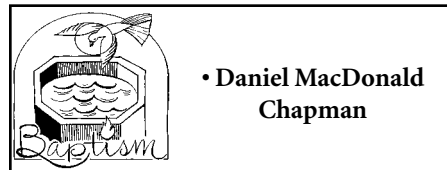
This group meets each Thursday morning after Mass.

Each of the five stories in this jubilantly acclaimed collection pays tribute to the wisdom and resilience of children, even in the face of the most agonizing circumstances. A family living in a makeshift shanty in urban Kenya scurries to find gifts of any kind for the impending Christmas holiday. A young brother and sister cope with their uncle's attempt to sell them



into slavery. Aboard a bus filled with refugees – a microcosm of today's Africa – a Muslim boy summons his faith to bear a treacherous ride across Nigeria. (We will be using a study guide.)
