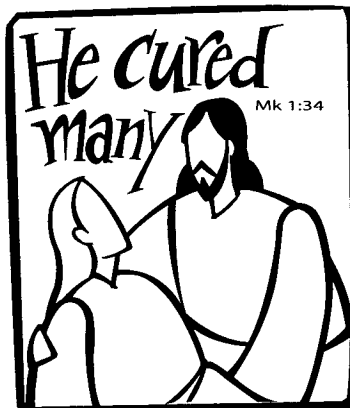

By Marilynne Robinson
A Novel

HOME is a book unsparring in its acknowledgment of sin and unstinting in its belief in the possibility of grace. Hailed as "in candescent," "magnificent," and "A literary miracle" (*Entertainment Weekly*), Robinson offers a brilliantly imagined retelling of the prodigal son parable, set at the same moment and in the same Iowa town as her *Gilead*.
