Scripture Reflection

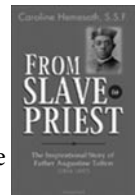

Father Tolton acknowledged the great gift of his Catholic faith, and despite bitter trials and turmoil, he remained faithful to the teachings of the Church. He was a visionary who saw far beyond race and politics, looking inward – into the heart of the Church herself. The greatest legacy of Fr. Augustine Tolton lies not in the fact that he was a pioneer, the first black American priest in the United States. Yes, he was that – but he was so much more! He loved and served the Lord with great fervor and intensity. He knew that God's love is so immense, its power so limitless, its embrace so tender and intimate, that Love Himself brings for the life. Father Tolton serves as a role model for those who seek to be conformed more perfectly to Christ.
