Scripture Reflection

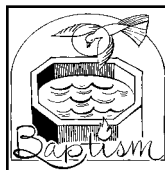
This group meets each Thursday morning

SEPTEMBER Book **Say You're One of Them** Uwem Akpan SJ (oo-wum-AKpan) *Fiction*

Each of the five stories in this jubilantly ac-
claimed collection pays tribute to the wisdom
and resilience of children, even in the face of
the most agonizing circum-
stances. A family liv-
ing in a makeshift shanty
in urban Kenya scurries to
find gifts of any kind for
the impending Christmas
holiday. A young brother
and sister cope with their
uncle's attempt to sell them
into slavery. Aboard a bus
filled with refugees – a
microcosm of today's Africa –
a Muslim boy summons his faith to bear a
treacherous ride across Nigeria. (We will be
using a study guide.)

Fr. Uwem Akpan was born and reared in Nige-
ria. He was ordained as a Jesuit priest in 2005.
